CREATE, EXPLORE, COLLABORATE

Summer Camp at The Co-op School provides a full day of the creative and performing arts integrated with literacy and science. Our program teams up musicians and movers, painters and players, science and sculptors for inventive collaborations.

FOR OUR 4 AND 5 YEAR OLDS (kids entering Kindergarten)

Our 4 and 5 year olds can choose from three themes that incorporate exploration in focused disciplines. Each one-week program culminates with a multi-disciplinary performance. Choose multiple weeks of the same theme or try all three.

BODY AND THE BEAT: the study of Capoeira with music and work in our woodshop, the campers will build their own instruments and use them to explore Brazilian themes and rhythms in music.

STORY ART: Incorporating the basic components of performing arts, campers will develop their own dramatic play, explore expressive movement and create scenery in our art studio for their performance.



SCIENCE ON THE MOVE: Fusing the physics of gymnastics with the foundations of science exploration, this program is geared towards the active intellect. The students spend the day involved in physical activity, hands on experimentation in science and 3-D construction in our art studio.

FOR OUR 5 AND 6 YEAR OLDS (kids entering First and Second Grade)

Our 5 and 6 year olds choose between two options. Each one-week program culminates with a multi-disciplinary performance. Choose multiple weeks of the same theme or try both!

LIVING STORIES: Students will focus on developing an advanced drama collaboratively. The students will work together to design a story, explore narrative through movement and music, and design and create the scenery for their final production.

ART AND THE PHYSICAL WORLD: Gymnastics, sculpture and science; a place where campers can get messy and explore! This group will focus on hands on science projects, artistic creations, and physical expression.



FOR OUR 7 AND 8 YEAR OLDS (kids entering Third Grade)

DIY DRAMA: Our most advanced performing arts camp program relies on the students to choose their own adventure. Highlighting process and product, campers will develop their own story through movement and music, and design and create their own scenery. A weekly field trip takes the group outside of their classrooms for inspiration. Guided by focused specialists the team works collaboratively on developing a premiere work.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

Campers ages two, three and four years old start their day with a familiar circle-time routine to introduce the activities of the day. Whether the day features music, storyarts, yoga or dance our kids are engaged in age-appropriate active creativity. The day's schedule includes lots of outside time with water play and sprinklers -- without getting overheated. Quiet times include arts and crafts.

Our preschool program takes place at 87 Irving Pl.
